Orwell station is a real location based between Derby Road and Trimley on the Felixstowe line. It is the only closed station which passenger trains still go through.			
Orwell station served the villiage of Nacton in the coastal region of Suffolk. It was closed to passengers in 1960, but the line remained open. The station is now a private house.			
1940s – The layout depicts Orwell station and the surrounding area as it may have been during World War II.			
1950s – The war is over, and Brits are travelling again. The layout depicts Orwell Station as it may have been after the war, with through Express and Holiday Excursions to Felixstowe.
